Part II- Narrative. Electronically submit your narrative. Questions that should be addressed in the narrative are listed for each respective category of the award. The narrative can be free form and should be a maximum of two pages 8 ½ “ X 11”, typed, double-spaced, one side only. Minimum One Page.

Part III- Letters of Endorsement.

2 Letters of Endorsement required. (1) One must be from another Youth Director in the SFAPAL Youth Directors program in which his/her own peer(s) support the nomination and can explain why they feel he or she would be a great awardee.

The (2nd) letter(s) should be from from other organizations or individuals having direct knowledge of the achievements of the nominee will be considered with this nomination. ***You may and are encouraged to submit more than (1) one letter from organizations and/or individuals.***

Scan these in and electronically submit them as well.

Recipients of the Max Trapasso Outstanding Youth Director Award will have the honor of receiving a plaque, a cash award of (\$1000.00) One Thousand Dollars and being honored at the Annual Youth Directors Conference and/or the Year End Membership Training Conference and having their story told to all meeting/event attendees. **The Winner must be present to receive their award during the Annual Membership Training Conference, held in December 2021 @ Disney’s Yacht Club Resort, Sunday, December 12, 2021. This may be subject to change due to the Covid-19 crisis.**

Eligibility for the Max Trapasso Outstanding Youth Director Award

- Must have participated in a PAL program for at least (1) one year.
- Must have been voted in or appointed to serve on SFAPAL's Youth Advisory Council (YAC) and/or Youth Conference Committee (YCC) program and served for at least (1) one year. Hint: Make sure to list the year you served.
- Copy of your last Report Card
- Must be a Senior in High School with plans on attending any university, college, tradeschool, Police Academy or local community college (send copy of your acceptance letter).
